## Promotion of agricultural machinery in Germany

Around 30 Argentine suppliers and institutions participated between 12 to 18 November in Agritechnica, the most important international fair for the agricultural technology industry, which took place Hannover, Germany.

With 325 m2 of exhibition space, the Argentine pavilion showcased different types of machinery, such as seeders, baggers, hoppers, headers, as well as software solutions for the sector.

In its last edition, the fair had 2,897 exhibitors from 47 countries, 448,912 visitors from 88 countries, 424,000 m2 of exhibition space and 180 technical conferences and forums.

## Argentine citizens in Malaysia and Brunei vote at the Embassy

In the framework of the second round of the presidential elections that took place in Argentina on last November 19, our Embassy opened from 8am-6pm to allow Argentine citizens residing in Malaysia and Brunei to cast their votes.



The Embassy was one the 137 consular and diplomatic Representations distributed in 86 countries that remained opened on that Sunday to allow the electoral participation of the more than 451,000 fellow nationals registered to vote abroad.

The elections were also a great opportunity for the Argentine community in Malaysia and Brunei to get together and mingle.

## The Argentine pavilion gathers 60 companies in CIIE, China



Argentina participated with a national pavilion at the China International Import Expo (CIIE) 2023 fair, a multi-sector exhibition organized by China and entirely dedicated to international suppliers, which took place from November 5 to 10 in Shanghai.

Coordinated by our Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the pavilion, that gathered 60 Argentine companies, was designed to promote our tourism and F&B sector. In this regard, food and wine tastings and tango shows, among other interactive activities, were held throughout the fair, together with an intensive agenda of business meetings organized by the Argentine Embassy in China and the Consulate in Shanghai.
