

Argentina and Malaysia: a relationship with growth potential



On January 26, the Argentine Minister of Foreign Affairs, Diana Mondino, received in her offices the Ambassador of Malaysia to the Argentine Republic, Nur Azman Abdul Rahim.

During the meeting, the authorities highlighted the longstanding friendship between both countries. Within that framework, they addressed matters of common interest, analyzed the development of bilateral relations and underlined the importance of further strengthening the relationship in various areas.

Furthermore, they stressed that there are considerable opportunities for trade and investments between both countries. In that regard, they agreed that bilateral economic relations have significant potential for expansion and diversification, especially concerning the opening of markets and the joint work between Petronas and YPF in the Argentine gas fields.

Deepening cooperation in education affairs

During January and February, our Embassy carried on working on one of its main lines of action: the deepening of the cooperation with Malaysia in matters of education.

In that regard, on January 8, we organized a meeting with

representatives of the Limkokwing University of Creative Technology, the first Malaysian private university, in order to explore different possibilities of association with Argentine universities, especially in the field of student exchange.

On another note, a few days later, our Ambassador met with the local Minister of Higher Education, Zambry Abdul Kadir (photo), in order to exchange views on how to expand the bilateral exchanges in those affairs, including the creation of permanent seminars in universities of both countries and professor exchanges.

Promotion of Argentine food exports: meeting with DVS

On January 23, organized by our Embassy with the goal of promoting scientific and technical exchanges and cooperation programs between relevant counterparts of our two countries, a virtual meeting took place between high authorities of the

Argentine National Institute of Industrial Technology (INTI) and the Standard & Industrial Research Institute of Malaysia (SIRIM).

In that framework, different association possibilities between the two institutions were explored, such as joint researches, trainings and information exchange, for example, in the field of certification standards.

High level meeting to expand lithium investments

During last month, our Minister of Foreign Affairs met with the CEO of Summit Nanotech, Amanda Hall, and company executives, who expressed their interest in landing in Argentina as suppliers of technology, innovation and studies on sustainable lithium extraction.

Summit Nonotech is a Canadian company focusing on investing in the extraction of resources lithium and, in this regard, its CEO referred during the meeting to the strategic agreement recently signed with Australian company Power Minerals to contribute to the development of a mining project in the province of Salta (North of Argentina).

Minister Mondino, in turn, highlighted the importance of the mining business to Argentina, as well as its significance in terms of energy transition, especially with respect to lithium exploration and exploitation. In addition, she offered details on the regulatory changes introduced to promote foreign investments in general and mining investments in particular. negotiation and administrative process currently in course to open the Malaysian market to new Argentine food products, we held a meeting with the Director General of the Department of Veterinary Services of Malaysia (DVS), Dr. Akma Ngah Hamid, and her team.

Argentina is one of the main food producers in the world and, in terms of consumer products, is currently present in the local market with a wide selection of wines and beef.
