On last May 3, together with other Latin American and the Spanish Embassies, we took part in the celebration of the "Spanish Language Day", organized in Eslite bookstore at Starhill Gallery, Kuala Lumpur.

During the event, officials of the Embassies of Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Cuba, Mexico, Peru, Spain and Uruguay, as well as representatives of the Spanish department of Universiti Malaya, read in Spanish and Bahasa Malaysia fragments of books from different Ibero-American authors.

In this framework, the Embassy of Argentina presented an excerpt of the book "Before the end" ("Antes del fin") from the renowned Argentine writer Ernesto Sábato.

Argentine companies promote businesses at tech fair in the US

Minister of FA: "Mining is a strategic sector in Argentina that will reach USD 19 billion in exports in 2030"

As part of his work agenda in Chile, Minister of Foreign Affairs Santiago Cafiero inaugurated in April the Argentine Pavilion at the Expomin 2023 international mining Fair, considered the main gathering of the sector in Latin America, where 22 Argentine companies, as well as public agencies, from Argentina participated in order to promote investment opportunities in our mining sector.

"The projections we have for the sector are very positive. With the developments that are taking place in Argentina today, we estimate that in 2030 we will reach USD 19 billion in exports," Minister Cafiero stressed, being lithium and copper the main products of this dynamic.

In the last decade, Argentina acquired a place of relevance in the world market of critical minerals. It currently holds the fourth place as a lithium producer in the world, after China, Australia and Chile. Together with Chile and Bolivia, it concentrates 65% of the world's reserves of the mineral.





The Argentine Ministry of Foreign Affairs coordinated the national presence at the eMerge Americas fair, one of the main technology conferences in the world, held during April in Miami, which attracted venture capitalists, entrepreneurs and technological innovators from the five continents.

In this scenario, Argentina deployed a 40m2 Pavilion where 20 companies from different parts of our country converged. This participation was part of the 2023 National Export Promotion Plan, a set of actions implemented by our Ministry in conjunction with other government agencies with the aim of increasing and diversifying Argentine sales to the world and adding value to our exports.

First exported radar arrives in Nigeria

Argentina completed in April the first sale to Nigeria of a radar for civil use built by the Argentine company INVAP S.E. The radar will be used for air traffic control in the African country, in what constitutes an outstanding achievement in our public strategy to promote and strengthen high tech exports.

After the delivery of the equipment, a team of specialized scientists and technicians will begin the final integration process and the radar testing phase.

For Argentina, this international operation opens the doors of the African market for its radar technology sector, and allows our country to strengthen its position and prestige as a responsible supplier of highly complex technology, generating good prospects to expand exports of this type to other nations as well.
